Dear Camp Bethel Supporters:

As I am sure that most of you know, Camp Bethel has been in need of improved housing for our full time staff for some time. Now is the time to finally begin construction of a new cabin. The plan is to construct a new cabin for the Camp Director to include office space that has long been needed and to move the Facilities Director in to the existing Directors cabin. The old (original) cabin where the Facilities Director currently lives does not afford the quality of housing that the Board of Directors feel we need to provide for our staff.

Upon completion of a new cabin, the original cabin will be used for summer kitchen help, speakers, and for other personnel as needed.

The anticipated cost of the new cabin which we plan to begin construction this summer will be about \$170,000.00 or close to \$100.00 per square foot. We are planning a two story structure to minimize building costs and to save money on heating the cabin as well. It will be possible to bring the quoted price down with the use of volunteer labor.

The Camp Bethel Board and I are asking that you consider sharing in the support of this building venture with your time and/or financial contribution.
